#### Alert Status Trend



The county wide assessment this week is **AMBER / OPEL 3** with **66%** of reporting practices assessed as **AMBER**, **7%** reporting as **RED**, **0%** as **BLACK** covering a total patient population of **258,982**. **GREEN** assessments account for **28%**.
